This trip is during the month of Elul, when we blow shofar every morning and spend time preparing for the High Holy Days through a process of Cheshbon Hanefesh (self-reflection). So in addition to our touring, swimming, playing, learning about the Jewish history and more with our tour guides and special guests, feasting on chef prepared meals on the boat, relaxing on the deck of our private yacht, becoming friends with those we do not know, enjoying the glorious scenery we will celebrate two Shabbatot together and study mussar/ middot (character traits) that will help us come to the Yamim Nora'im (Days of Awe) in a more mindful manner. Our trip will end with an intimate slichot service (the service that kicks off the Holidays) on our hotel rooftop or on the beach.

DAY 2

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 5, 2025 OUR JOURNEY BEGINS

- Upon landing in **Dubrovnik**, we'll begin our exploration with a
 panoramic ride on the cable car to the **Vidikovac observation** point, offering breathtaking views of the old city, sea and
 islands beyond.
- Enjoy lunch at your leisure in the city's charming streets.
- This afternoon, we check into our hotel and take a scenic walk to Tvrdava Lovrijenac, an imposing fortress offering a unique vantage point of Dubrovnik's city walls.
- We'll welcome Shabbat with a special Kabbalat Shabbat service at the historic Dubrovnik Synagogue, one of the oldest Sephardic synagogues in Europe still in use, then return to our hotel for a festive Shabbat dinner.

DAY 4 SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 7, 2025 SAILING TO SLANO

- Breakfast at our hotel.
- Enjoy a leisurely start with an optional Shacharit service on the beach, weather permitting. Take the morning to relax and absorb the serene atmosphere of Shabbat.
- After checking out of our hotel, we embark on a guided walking tour of Dubrovnik's Old Town, delving into its Jewish heritage and storied past.
- Limud Session: Later, we engage in a study session at the synagogue with members of the local Jewish community.
- Seudah Shlishit: We gather for a traditional third meal before a beautiful Havdalah service as we bid farewell to Shabbat.
- This evening, we **board our private yacht** and settle in for our first night on the Adriatic Sea.

- Start your day with breakfast on board as we sail towards Slano. Enjoy a lecture from our tour director on Croatia's Jewish and maritime history.
- Musar Session: Join Cantor Abrams for an inspiring Musar lesson, focusing on Jewish ethical teachings.
- After lunch on board, we'll explore the quaint village of Slano on a guided walking tour, followed by free time to stroll or perhaps indulge in a local wine tasting.
- Our Captain's Dinner will feature live Croatian music, creating a festive and memorable night on the ship.

DAY 6 TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2025
THE BLUE CAVE & VIS ISLAND

- Breakfast aboard our yacht.
- This morning, we visit the tranquil Mljet
 National Park, known for its emerald lakes and lush landscapes, and experience the serene beauty of this protected paradise.
- Enjoy lunch on board as we sail to Korčula, the fabled birthplace of Marco Polo. We'll explore this charming island on a walking tour and witness a traditional Moreska sword dance performance, a local spectacle of music and drama.
- Dinner is at your leisure in one of Korčula's picturesque seaside restaurants.

- Our journey takes us to Biševo, where we'll visit the mesmerizing Blue Cave, famous for its glowing blue light. A magical experience awaits as we glide through the cave's stunning waters.

 Shabbat at the local synagogue, followed
 by a delicious Shabbat dinner back on the ship.

- After a relaxing breakfast, we join together for Shacharit service on the upper deck.

- This afternoon, we check into our hotel and enjoy free time to explore the city at our own pace.
- We conclude Shabbat with a Selichot ceremony on the beach, offering spectacular views of Split at sunset.
- Dinner is at your leisure, with plenty of dining options to choose from in the city.
